The process of securing effective patent protection is complex and hence best undertaken by a qualified patent attorney. Our range of capped-cost services set us apart from other firms by providing you with a range of packaged options which can be matched to your commercial requirements, and the budget available.

Our entry-level **BASIC** package establishes “patent pending” rights in the United Kingdom and places you firmly on the first rung of the patent ladder without any compromise on quality. This option includes:

- An initial consultation (up to 40 minutes) with one of our fully qualified Chartered UK and European Patent Attorneys. That consultation - be it in person, by email, telephone, Skype® etc - enables our attorneys to capture and understand the necessary technical information relating to your invention; and to gain an appreciation of the surrounding commercial context.
- Reassurance that all information you disclose to us is covered by “client-attorney legal privilege” and hence automatically entirely confidential. This is confirmed by [Section 280 of the UK Copyright, Design and Patents Act 1988](#).
- A high quality patent description drafted by an attorney having at least 12 years’ drafting experience, and holding a scientific degree.
- A maximum of 12-pages of descriptive text, including formal “statements of invention” (there is no limit on the number of pages of drawings).
- Up to two revisions of the draft description before filing.
- Electronic filing of the patent application at the UK Intellectual Property Office.
- Checking of the accuracy of the official Filing Receipt issued by the UK Intellectual Property Office; and a letter from us confirming all filing details; confirming the downstream procedure and deadlines; and providing practical

advice on how to assert your pending patent rights on your product, literature, website etc.

As an optional extra, we offer a **mini IP audit** (cost: £350 plus VAT) which provides advice on any other intellectual property rights - e.g. registered or unregistered designs, trade marks, copyright etc. - that may be relevant to your invention.

Our **BASIC** package may not be the most appropriate choice in all cases. For example, if it is important for you to be provided with an early (i.e. within approx. 3 to 6 months) official indication as to whether or not your invention is patentable then please refer to our **BASIC-PLUS** package. Similarly, if you are seeking future cost certainty beyond the filing date of your patent application then we have a range of capped-cost options, right up to our **ALL INCLUSIVE** package. Finally, inventions which you (or we) deem to be unusually complex, or which you (or we) believe are of outstanding commercial importance, may require additional drafting time falling outside the scope of this **BASIC** package. If we believe this to be the case, we will advise you accordingly. The ultimate authority for granting or rejecting a patent application is the UK Intellectual Property Office and so no patent attorney can provide a guarantee that your application will be granted. However, it is worth bearing in mind that the process provides numerous opportunities to overcome any objections raised, and there is an appeal process in the event of an application being rejected.

Please note that responding to additional general queries or providing advice in relation to matters not specifically mentioned above would incur additional costs consistent with the amount of professional time incurred.
